Named Insured	City of Toronto 'User Groups' (as on file), with the City of Toronto added as an Additional Insured
	The "user groups" refer to the renters or users of the City facility - the name or group that is on the certificate.
	"As on file" means that the insurance company requires a record of 'users' – this is done by the quarterly reports submitted by the City.
Coverage	Coverage applies to Sport, Recreation & Leisure Activities ONLY while using City of Toronto facilities
Limit	\$2,000,000 each occurrence and aggregate where applicable
Sublimits	Medical Expense \$25,000 any one person
	Medical Expense \$25,000 any one occurrence
	Tenant's Legal Liability \$250,000 any one premises
Deductibles	\$500 per occurrence combined Bodily Injury/Property Damage/Legal Expense
	\$500 any one premises – Tenants Legal Liability
Loss Reporting Provisions	As per Section IV, Condition 5. on page 14 of the policy - Report to the insurer "promptly" any occurrence which may result in a claim.
Extensions	Tenant's Legal Liability (All Risks)
	Incidental Medical Malpractice Liability
	Non-Owned Automobile Liability
	Volunteers added as additional insureds
	Forest Fire Fighting Expenses (\$500,000 Sublimit)
